

Interested in creating a team for the Pre-Collegiate League? Here are a few FAQs to help you with the process!

Q: How many kids do I need to create a team?

A: You need at least 5 boys and 5 girls by the registration deadline in order to have a team. Additional players can be added throughout the season.

Q: Does a team have to consist of kids from the same school?

A: No. We know that many kids have friends at other schools that they would like to play with so that is definitely not a requirement. If the kids are from different schools then you can be creative with the team name – we are flexible!

Q: How do I know what level to choose for my team?

A: We classify the levels in this way: Level A is for higher intermediate-advanced players. Level B is for beginner-lower intermediate players. The Middle School B divisions will be using green dot balls. Please check the rules for our tournament player guidelines as some players are required to play on an A level team.

Q: Our school does not have courts; does this mean that we cannot participate?

A: Of course you all can play in the league! Teams can play out of a neighborhood, school, facility, or park as long as there are at least 2 courts at the location. Lighted courts are not a requirement for the league.

Q: I have 5 boys and 5 girls ready to play, how do I create a team?
