CITY CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

DeKalb Tennis Center

Reminder Regarding Covid: USTA Atlanta is still adhering to the CDC guidelines regarding the pandemic. We ask that captains encourage their players to social distance from other teams as much as possible when not on court. When inside the tennis center, we do ask that players **wear a mask if they are not fully vaccinated. We also would like to ask that players limit their time inside the building to bathroom breaks, water refills and score reporting in order to manage crowding in a small space indoors.**

Captains only must check in at the tournament table at least ½ hour prior to your scheduled match time. Your entire team must be present on the grounds before you check in. The captain will complete the championship scorecard. Once completed, no change can be made except for injury to a player during warm-up. *Please be sure your ENTIRE team is present at least ½ hour before your scheduled match time.* It is especially important for those in the first time slot to be there on time. The first matches will start as soon as both teams are present!



All matches will be scheduled for play at the same time, providing courts are available, and must be played to completion unless otherwise directed by the Program Director. The format for city finals is best 2 out of 3 sets with a mandatory 10 pt tiebreak in lieu of a complete 3rd set.

Balls will be provided by USTA. Players should make certain that they are on the specific court to which they are assigned and that they are playing the proper opponents.

Each team is responsible for their drinks and refreshments. Bathroom visits, filling of water jugs and stretching is to be done in advance so that the players can take the courts immediately upon being called to start warm-ups. Delays will result in point penalties.

Warm-up is limited to ten (10) minutes, including serves. When the warm-up is complete an USTA Atlanta representative will instruct players to begin and play must start immediately. One member of each doubles team and each singles player must come to the desk to report the score as soon as the match is completed.

Every effort will be made to complete all matches on the scheduled days of the City Championship. However, if there is rain at Dekalb Tennis Center on the scheduled day and no matches are played, the entire schedule will move to the rain date. If only part of the tournament is cancelled due to weather, the make up schedule will be decided upon by the Program Director.

It is our goal to adhere to the schedule. However, captains must be aware that flexibility is the key to any successful tournament. Please make sure that your team is available for the entire day
